Ontario Pesticide Classification**

Technicians/Trainees must be directly supervised to use some Class 3 products. Products containing Class 9 active ingredients are banned for cosmetic use but may be used for exceptions under the ban.

7	General Vendor Limited Vendor	Anyone Note: Bear repellents are restricted to persons aged 16 or older and the purchaser must sign the record of sale.		For non-cosmetic uses only unless excepted under the ban, e.g. use of Domestic ready to use glyphosate to control plants poisonous to humans by touch. A vendor must give information about appropriate use to the purchaser.
8	List of Domestic pesticide products that are banned for sale or use.			
9	List of active ingredients that are banned for cosmetic use; certain uses are permitted under exceptions to the ban.			
10	List of active ingredients contained in pesticide products in Class 2, 3, 4 or 7 that may be used to destroy plants that are poisonous to humans by touch.			
11	List of active ingredients that are biopesticides or certain lower risk that are allowed for cosmetic use. Green notice signs must be posted when used in, on, or over land by 1) a licensed applicator, and 2) a person in non-residential areas.			

NOTE: Persons holding a permit issued by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment or a confirmation or approval letter signed by the Director under the Act may purchase and use a Class 2, 3, or 4 pesticide as authorized,.
